COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is modeled on the Core Course of Group Psychotherapy designed by the American Group Psychotherapy Association. Upon its completion, participants will have met the core course requirement of the National Registry of Certified Group Psychotherapy. Class discussion will include a didactic component, utilizing the clinical experiences of participants. Active engagement in these discussions is expected. There will be assigned reading and four brief writing assignments.

SCHEDULE

Classes meet on Wednesday's throughout January, February and March of 2011, from 7:15PM until 8:45PM.

ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION

This course is intended for any interested practitioner of group therapy, regardless of professional discipline. Non-clinicians with an interest in group process may apply and be considered on a case-by-case basis.
